How Does It Work?

EVERY Tuesday night, starting January 17, 2012, at the Asian Herald Library (1339 Baxter St, Charlotte NC 28204), chess expert and coach Peter Giannatos will give a 45 minute lecture beginning at 6:45PM. At 7:30PM students will have the opportunity to play a rated game of chess. The time control for the game will be G/45 meaning that both students will have 45 minutes each to complete their game. This will allow parents and students to leave chess club no later than 9PM. The cost per week, per student is five dollars and students must be Queen City Chess members (\$10/y). Four of the five dollars will go to a fund to support their chess club. The top school will get 60% of the funds to use for nationals and/or their school chess supplies. The school coming in second will receive 40% of the funds to use for the same needs. The top 2 schools will be determined by who had the most student participants. This event is open to all students, CMS or private.
